## *Water Sustainability Act*

### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

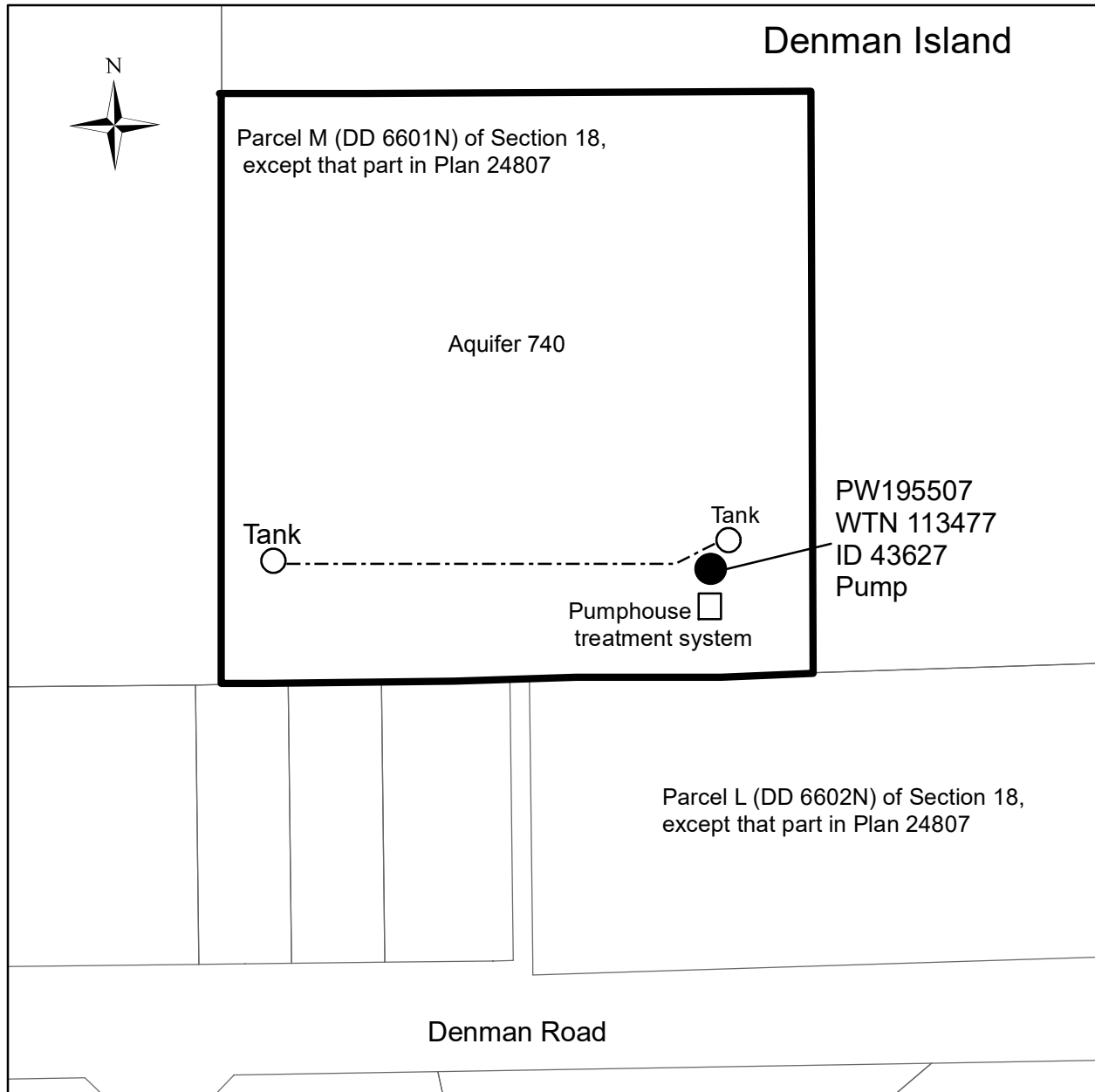
The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The aquifer on which the rights are granted is 740.
- b) The point of well diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is March 5, 2018.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is industrial (commercial enterprise).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for industrial (commercial enterprise) purpose is 3.68 cubic metres per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Parcel M (DD 6601N) of Section 18, Denman Island, Nanaimo District, except that part in Plan 24807.
- h) The authorized works are pipe, pumphouse, treatment system, pump, two tanks and well which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2023. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The licensee shall install a flow measuring device to the satisfaction of the Water Manager under the *Water Sustainability Act*.
- k) The licensee shall retain flow meter records for inspection upon request by the Water Manager under the *Water Sustainability Act*.
- l) The licensee must collect water quality samples to be analyzed by an accredited laboratory for parameters indicative of salt water intrusion, including chloride, specific electrical conductivity and total dissolved solids, annually, during the driest time of the year, for three consecutive years following commencement of regular operation of the well and at a minimum of once every five years thereafter or as otherwise specified by the Water Manager.

- m) The licensee shall maintain records of water quality analysis results for inspection upon request by the Water Manager. The water quality analysis results shall be compared to operational water quality objectives as specified by the Water Manager. If any operational objectives are exceeded, the licensee shall notify the Water Manager in writing within 30 days of the occurrence.
